

HOME FIRE SAFETY CHECKLIST

The Colorado Springs Fire Department wants to help you prevent home fires and to be aware of hazards in your home. If there is a fire, you may have less than 3 minutes to get out of your home. Make sure everyone in your home knows what to do if there is a fire.

SN	OKE & CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS
	Smoke alarms are on every level of your home. Smoke alarms are inside and outside each sleeping areas. Smoke alarms are less than 10 years old. Smoke alarm batteries are replaced as needed (unless it is 10 year tamper proof alarm). Carbon monoxide alarms are on every level of your home. Carbon monoxide alarms are less than 7 years old. All smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are tested monthly.
EL	ECTRICAL & APPLIANCES
	Electrical cords are in good condition (not frayed or damaged). Electrical cords are not running across doorways or under carpets. All extension cords are used safe (not under carpets or across walking areas). Replace missing or broken electrical outlet cover or switch plates. Appliances are plugged into separate electrical outlets. Portable space heaters are 3 ft. away from anything that can burn.
UT	ILITIES & HOUSEKEEPING
	The furnace has been inspected in the past year. The chimney has been inspected and cleaned in the past year. Maintain a 3 ft clearance around the furnace from combustible materials. Area around the electrical panel is accessible and free of clutter. Bathroom exhaust fans are clean and free of lint. Matches and lighters are kept out of reach of children in a secure place. Flammables are stored in sturdy metal containers and in a cool place. The clothes dryer has a clean vent and filter (there is no lint build-up).
CC	OKING & KITCHEN
	NEVER LEAVE COOKING UNATTENDED! If there is food cooking on the stovetop, an adult is present. Pot handles are always turned toward the back of the stove. Combustible and other flammable materials are away from the stovetop. Always set a timer or reminder when cooking on the stove or oven.
	The oven is never used to heat the home. Stove and oven(s) are clean and free of built up splatter and grease.
